

Guidelines for Happy Hill Community Garden

1. My plot is 20 x 20 ft. and I will not expand my plot beyond this measurement or into paths or other plots.
2. I will keep my plot free from weeds, pests and insects.
3. Any tools or other items I bring from home I will take back home.
4. I will not bring household trash and leave at the Happy Hill Community Garden.
5. I will not plant any illegal plants.
6. I will not drink; use illegal drugs or garden while under the influence of illegal drugs.
7. I will not take food or plants from other gardeners' plots.
8. I will respect other gardeners and I will not use abusive or profane language or discriminate against others.
9. Unattended watering is not permitted.
10. Plantings should be organized in such a way that neighboring plots are not shaded.
11. Make sure that trailing vines are prevented from advancing on neighboring plots.
12. Dispose of weeds and plant materials in designated compost areas.
13. Harvest only from your assigned plot.
14. No pets are allowed in gardening area.
15. Please supervise young children so they do not disturb other plots.
16. Please park in designated areas and don't drive vehicles in garden area.
17. The garden is open from dawn until dusk.
18. The registration fee is for gardening from April 1, 2006 – March 31, 2007
19. Gardner must adhere to water limitations when imposed by the City.

Your compliance with the above regulations will help everyone have an enjoyable and prosperous garden. Failure to comply with above regulations during the season may result in a loss of future gardening privileges and forfeiture of all fees.
