The Mayor and Rocky Mount City Council will consider appointments to several City boards and commissions at an upcoming Committee of the Whole meeting. Applications will be accepted until June 14, 2019. Appointments will be finalized by the City Council on July 8, 2019.

### **Following is a list of appointments to be considered:**

- Animal Care and Control Advisory Board - five (5) appointments: Wards 1, 2, 3, 4 and 6;
- Board of Adjustment - four (4) appointments: Wards 2, 5, 6 and Alternate Member;
- Business Development Authority – two (2) appointments;
- Central City Revitalization Panel - four (4) appointments: one (1) Downtown Renaissance, Inc.; two (2) Members-at-Large; and one (1) Ex-Officio member;
- Community Appeals Board - three (3) appointments: Wards 2, 3 and 5;
- Historic Preservation Commission - four (4) appointments;
- Housing Authority - two (2) appointments: one (1) member and one (1) public housing member;
- Human Relations Commission – two (2) Mayoral appointments; four (4) City Council appointments;
- Internal Audit Committee – four (4) appointments: three (3) appointments from the business community with experience in finance, management or business and one (1) Certified Public Accountant (CPA);
- Martin Luther King, Jr. Commission – six (6) appointments: five (5) members and one (1) Human Relations Commission ex-officio appointee;
- Mayor's Commission on Persons with Disabilities – four (4) appointments;
- Planning Board – two (2) appointments: Wards 4 and 7;
- Rocky Mount – Wilson Airport Authority – one (1) appointment;
- Transportation Advisory Committee – three (3) appointments;
- Tree Advisory Board – two (2) appointments - Wards 1 and 5;
- Utility Service Review Board – one (1) appointment: Ward 6; and
- Workforce Housing Advisory Commission – six (6) appointments: Ward 4, Ward 7, one (1) Faith-based Community member, one (1) Housing Developer member and one (1) Business Community member.

The individuals presently serving on these various boards whose terms are expiring are eligible for reappointment and may be considered by the Mayor and City Council in the appointment process along with any other applicants.

Mayor David W. Combs, commenting on the contributions of the various boards and commissions, said, "The roles of the various Boards and Commissions of the City of Rocky Mount are essential to the effective operation of our local government. The citizens who make up these boards give of their time voluntarily and without compensation but render a tremendous service to all our community. We are fortunate to have individuals of very high caliber willing to serve on these boards. The results of their service have been to the benefit of the entire City."
